



Driver Training Bursary Application Form

Section 1 – Program Summary

The Take the Wheel Drivers Training Bursary provides youth in and from care between the ages of 16 and 24, support to get their Class 7 (novice or N) license in BC. The bursary awards youth up to \$1500 to cover the cost of a professional driver's training course or package. The Take the Wheel Driver Training Bursary is funded by the Ministry of Children and Family Development (MCFD) and is administered by the Federation of BC Youth in Care Networks. The Take the Wheel Driver's Training Bursary will award 48 bursaries over the course of 2018-2019.

Please complete all necessary sections of this application. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

Note: If you are a youth in and from care between the ages of 16 and 18, in order for you to be eligible for a Take the Wheel Driver Training Bursary, you must provide proof that you have requested your social worker cover the costs of a driver's training program and that they are unable to do so.

It will take between 4-6 weeks after the application submission deadline for applicants to hear back from us regarding the status of their application. It will take an additional 4-6 weeks for successful candidates to be notified that their bursary funds have arrived at their chosen driving school.

Eligibility

- Applicants have a cumulative total of at least one year of experience in BC government care under one or more of the following:
 - Continuing Custody Order (CCO)
 - Temporary Custody Order (TCO)
 - Voluntary Care Agreement (VCA)
 - Special Needs Agreement (SNA)
 - Youth Agreement (YAG)
- o Applicants are between the ages of 16 and 24 years old
- Applicants are a Canadian Citizen or Landed Immigrant
- o Applicants have a valid Learner's (L) license with a minimum of 6 months before it will expire

How to Apply

- Complete an application package and include all required documents (see next page and use the checklist at the end of this form)
- Submit completed application package with all required documents before each round's deadline
 - Round 1 deadline October 18, 2018
 - Round 2 deadline March 8, 2019
 - Round 3 deadline July 5, 2019

Required Documents

Documentation of the following is required for an application to be considered complete:

- Proof that the applicant has a valid L license with a minimum of 6 months before it will expire, by providing a copy of your license.
- o Documentation verifying the name, location, and cost of the drivers training course or program you are wanting to participate in.
- o Proof of care letter stating you have a cumulative total of at least one year of experience in BC government care.
- One reference letter can be from a teacher, advisor, employer or supportive adult in your life, stating why you would be a good candidate to receive the Take the Wheel Driver's Training Bursary.
- For youth between the ages of 16 and 18, a letter from your guardian or social worker confirming their support of your Driver Training Bursary application and explaining why they cannot cover the costs of the program for you.
- o Complete application package including answers to all essay questions.
- Sign-off on Applicant Declarations.
