



License Support Bursary Application Form

Section 1 – Program Summary

The Take the Wheel License Support Bursary provides youth in and from care between the ages of 16 and 24 support to get their Class 7 license by awarding youth up to \$250 to go towards covering the cost of a Learner's (L) test and license, Novice (N) road test and license, or help pay off outstanding transit fines that prevent a youth from obtaining their license.

The Take the Wheel License Support Bursary is funded by the Ministry of Children and Family Development (MCFD) and is administered by the Federation of BC Youth in Care Networks. The Take the Wheel License Support Bursary will award 48 bursaries over the course of 2018-2019.

Please complete all necessary sections of this application. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

Note: If you are a youth in and from care between the ages of 16 and 18, in order for you to be eligible for a Take the Wheel License Support Bursary, you must provide proof that you have requested your social worker cover the costs of obtaining your L license, N license, or covering your transit fines, and that they are unable to do so.

It will take between 4-6 weeks after the application submission deadline for applicants to hear back from us regarding the status of their application.

Eligibility

- o Applicants have a cumulative total of at least one year of experience in BC government care under one or more of the following:
 - Continuing Custody Order (CCO)
 - Temporary Custody Order (TCO)
 - Voluntary Care Agreement (VCA)
 - Special Needs Agreement (SNA)
 - Youth Agreement (YAG)
- Applicants are between the ages of 16 and 24 years old
- o Applicants are a Canadian Citizen or Landed Immigrant

How to Apply

- o Complete an application package and include all required documents (see next page and use the checklist at the end of this form).
- Submit completed application package with all required documents before each round's deadline.
 - Round 1 deadline October 18, 2018
 - Round 2 deadline March 8, 2019
 - Round 3 deadline July 5, 2019

Documentation of the following is required for an application to be considered complete:

- o A copy of outstanding Translink- or ICBC-held transit fines including amounts and dates.
- Estimated date of L or N license test.
- o Proof of Care letter stating you have a cumulative total of at least one year of experience in BC government care.
- One reference letter can be from a teacher, advisor, employer or supportive adult in your life stating why you would be a good candidate to receive the Take the Wheel License Support bursary.
- For youth between the ages of 16 and 18, a letter from your guardian or social worker confirming their support of your License
 Support Bursary application and an explanation for why they cannot cover the costs for you to obtain your L license, N license, or transit fines.
- Complete application package including answers to all essay questions.
