Unconditional Income Support (UIS)

1. Age 19 (up to 20 birthday)

2. ONE of the following applies to you:

- On your 19 birthday, your care status was:
 - Youth Agreement,
 - Continuing Custody Order (CCO), or
 - Under the Guardianship of a Director / Director of Adoption
- You spent at least 24 months in care (any status) between ages 12 - 19
- You were adopted/had your custody permanently transferred to someone other than your parent(s) between ages 12 - 19
- You were in comparable arrangements under Indigenous law

Conditional Income Support (CIS)

1. Age 20-26 (up to 27 birthday)

2. Attending life-skills, training, educational, vocational, cultural, or rehabilitative programming.

3. ONE of the following applies to you:

- On your 19 birthday, your care status was:
 - Youth Agreement,
 - Continuing Custody Order (CCO), or
 - Under the Guardianship of a Director / Director of Adoption
- You spent at least 24 months in care (any status) between ages 12 - 19
- You were adopted/had your custody permanently transferred to someone other than your parent(s) between ages 12 - 19
- You were in comparable arrangements under Indigenous law



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SAJE Life-skills, Training & Cultural Connections Funding (LSTCC)

- Aged 19-26 (up to 27 birthday)
- You are on **ONE** of the following agreements:
 1. Income Support (UIS or CIS)
 2. Agreement with Young Adult (AYA)

Rent Supplement

1. Age 20-26 (up to 27 birthday)
2. Renting in the private market in BC
3. **ONE** of the following applies to you:
 - On your 19 birthday, your care status was:
 - Youth Agreement,
 - Continuing Custody Order (CCO), or
 - Under the Guardianship of a Director / Director of Adoption
 - You spent at least 24 months in care (any status) between ages 12 - 19
 - You were adopted/had your custody permanently transferred to someone other than your parent(s) between ages 12 - 19
 - You were in comparable arrangements under Indigenous law

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

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SAJE Housing Agreements (SHA)

1. Age 19-20 (up to 21 birthday)
2. On your 19th birthday, you were living in a foster home, group home, or in the care of a relative
3. Your caregiver agrees to a SHA
4. **ONE of the following applies to you:**
 - On your 19 birthday, your care status was:
 - Youth Agreement,
 - Continuing Custody Order (CCO), or
 - Under the Guardianship of a Director / Director of Adoption
 - You spent at least 24 months in care (any status) between ages 12 - 19
 - You were adopted/had your custody permanently transferred to someone other than your parent(s) between ages 12 - 19
 - You were in comparable arrangements under Indigenous law

SAJE Support Agreements (SSA)

1. Age 19-20 (up to 21 birthday)
2. **ONE of the following applies to you:**
 - On your 19 birthday, your care status was:
 - Youth Agreement,
 - Continuing Custody Order (CCO), or
 - Under the Guardianship of a Director / Director of Adoption
 - You spent at least 24 months in care (any status) between ages 12 - 19
 - You were adopted/had your custody permanently transferred to someone other than your parent(s) between ages 12 - 19
 - You were in comparable arrangements under Indigenous law

 4. Agreement with Young Adult (AYA)
